You are probably receiving this note because your child's teacher thinks your child is a strong mathematician with huge potential.

We are Talent-Ed, a charity that is dedicated to helping students reach their potential, and we are excited to invite your child to a maths webinar that they will find enjoyable and stimulating. It will be hosted by best-selling author Simon Singh and Countdown champion Junaid Mubeen.

Attending one of these webinars may lead to your child being offered a free place on one of our programmes for students in Year 7, either:

- **Maths Masterclass Tutorials**, a 5-year programme of weekly online tutorials, in which experienced tutors work with six students to deepen their mathematical thinking and problem-solving skills.
- **The Challenge Programme**, a year of free monthly webinars focussed on problem-solving skills, presented by high-profile instructors.

The first term of ten masterclasses are free for all students, and students from disadvantaged backgrounds will continue to have free places for five years. The remaining students who wish to continue will receive subsidised places at £5 per masterclass.
