All objectives apart from speaking will be assessed in the Internal Assessment.

AO3 - Speaking - is an endorsement this year and will be assessed informally during lesson time. There is a Pass/Fail/Merit/Distinction grading system and criteria will be shared with students.

The final grade for GCSE MFL will be derived from the results of:

- 1) Internal Assessments
- 2) Classroom based assessments from across Year 11
- 3) Mock exam performance

What can students do next?

Students should focus their revision on the topic areas and skills outlined above using a variety of revision tools which will be shared in lessons between now and Easter. There are already resources on the Google Classrooms to support this.
